The Abstract should not exceed 2 A4 pages, including figures, tables, references, etc. The name of the speaker must be underlined. The layout of the publication must be completely composed by the authors, figures and tables must be embedded into the text accordingly.

Margins on all sides should be 2.5 cm. The file should be made-up by the authors ready for direct printing with all tables and figures embedded in the text. Please, use Times New Roman 12 and single-line spacing for the title, author names, affiliations and the main text. The title, author names and affiliations must be centered and are separated from the main text by an empty line. The main text must be justified. No hyphenation in the text or title is allowed. The indentation at a paragraph beginning - 0.75 cm. Heading and paragraph centering in the text have to be done using MS Word.

Figure captions should be directly below the figure embedded in the main text as Times New Roman 10, single-spaced, centered text. Table headings should be placed above the table body as Times New Roman 10, single-spaced, justified text.

The file should be submitted in MS Word for Windows format with name <First Author>.docx. Line drawings should be sent as separate files prepared by Corel Draw or Adobe Illustrator. The text in these figures should be converted into curves. Photos should be sent as a separate 300 dpi TIFF file.

References in the text should be placed in parenthesis, for example (Sobolev et al., 2020). Please, use the template below for the reference list formatting.
