



Abstracts should correspond to the <u>template</u>. Conference Proceedings in print and electronic form will be published according to the results of the conference. Please note that only one abstract can be submitted by one participant.

Participation in the conference is free, registration fees are charged only from the participants of field trip.

TRAVEL AND VISA INFORMATION

Starting from the 1st of January 2015 citizens of most countries of the CIS that are not included in a Custom union (Azerbaijan, Moldova, Tajikistan, Turkmenistan, Uzbekistan) need a foreign passport (no visa required) to enter the Russian Federation. 

FIELD TRIPS



Field Trip: Geology, magmatism and metallogeny of Gorny Altai

Leaders: Pavel Kotler, Anna Kulikova **Technical Managers**: Evgeniy Mikheev

Date: 18-24 June 2022

Cost: 25000 RUB (about 290 EUR or 330 USD) including transportation, accommodation (hotels and tourist camping), meals, field guidebook in English, logistical support. The final cost may be changed depending upon number of participants.

Max/Min number of participants: 25/15

General Information:

The field excursion includes field observations of the main and easily accessible geological objects in Altai Mountains. The program of excursion includes:

- 1) Study of sedimentary, metamorphic and magmatic complexes illustrating the evolution of the geological structure of the Gorny Altai in Early Paleozoic (oceanic and island-arc stage), Middle Paleozoic (active continental margin stage) and Late Paleozoic Mesozoic (intraplate stage);
 - 2) Visit the gold, mercury and polymetallic deposits in the Gorny Altai;
- 3) Familiarization with Cenozoic landforms and complexes illustrating the latest tectonic activity of the Altai Mountains.

During the trip we will also enjoy beautiful views of the Altai Mountains.

Expected weather conditions: Sunny, small chance of rain. It may be hot during the day (up to 30° C) but cold during the night ($+5 \div +10^{\circ}$ C). Windy weather and sudden weather changes are available. You must have warm clothes.

General Information:

The field geophysical excursion is aimed at young geoscientists wishing to get acquainted closer with diverse geophysical techniques and take direct part in state-of-the-art equipment measurements. A presumable set of methods and tools includes electrical resistivity tomography (ERT) and electromagnetic sounding (scanner). We plan to visit a geophysical observatory in IPGG electromagnetic polygon in the neighborhood of Akademgorodok. Besides, the field excursion affords a unique opportunity for sharing experiences, informal socializing and making new acquaintances.
